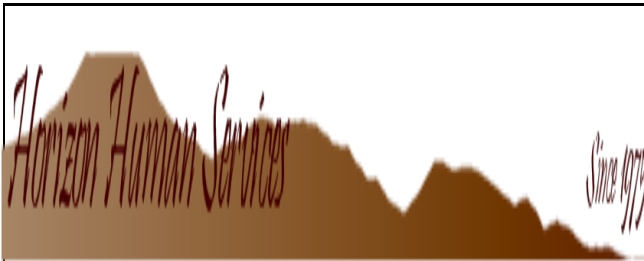

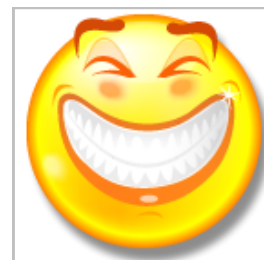

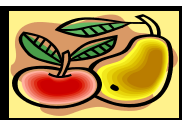

The Public Fiduciary's Office serves as the guardian and/or conservator for vulnerable adults after it is determined through a court process the person is unable to make decisions due to incapacity. As the guardian, the office makes decisions for the person's placement and medical care. As the conservator, the office pays the person's bills and handles their financial affairs. The Public Fiduciary will only be appointed if there is no one else that is willing or able to serve in this capacity.

The Public Fiduciary may also serve as the Personal Representative in probate cases. Again, the cases are referred to them when the decedent has no one else willing or able to serve.

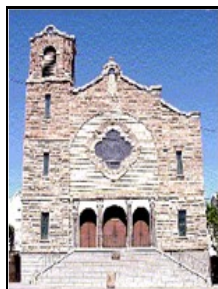

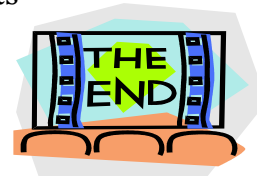

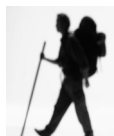
